2 23-07-2024 1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Imadpur
P.S. Case No.29/2024 dated 01.04.2024 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian
Penal Code. It is next submitted that investigation in the case is
still going on.

3. The learned APP at the outset submits that the
offences for which the instant F.I.R. has been instituted against
the petitioner carries a punishment of less than 7 years to which
the learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute.

4. In view of the submission made by the learned APP
the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the



order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar).

5. The petitioner would be at liberty to file a representation within a period of three weeks from today before the concerned Superintendent of Police of the district and the Investigating Officer of the case with a web copy of the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar) and the Superintendent of Police shall ensure that Investigating Officer of the case strictly adhere to the direction contained in the said order.
