4 02-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 498A/354 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code and sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have resolved their dispute in terms of settlement mutually agreed upon by them. A copy of the settlement is annexed with the mediator's report dated 2.4.2024.

5. Considering the mediator's report, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, mentioned above, be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sherghati, Gaya in Barachatti Mohanpur Police Station Case No. 182 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as in terms of settlement.
