ORAL ORDER

2 24-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

*"I) For the issuance of writ/writs, direction/
directions in the nature of Mandamus
against the Respondents for payment of
difference of salary of petitioner because
his 1st A.C.P. given on 01.06.2001 in place
of 10.03.1998 and 2nd A.C.P given on*



01.06.2009 in place of 10.03.2008 because petitioner joined on 10.03.1988 at the post of Class 4th (Anusewak) in Karai Parsurai Block, under District of Nalanda and retired from his service on 17.11.2017.

II) For issuance of direction/directions, order/orders to the respondents to payment the all arrear amount with interest of 12% upon dues salary as well as retrial benefit for which petitioner has already entitled."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Nalanda at Biharsharif for redressal of his aforesaid grievance. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case appropriate representation is filed, within a period of two weeks from today, the District Magistrate, Nalanda at Biharsharif shall dispose off the same by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks,



thereafter.

4. The writ petition stands disposed off on
the aforesaid terms.
