2. Learned counsel for the State submits that the copy

No. 7938 of 2020 before the respondent no. 3 (the Director, Primary Education, Bihar, Patna) and the respondent no. 3 would pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within four weeks, after personally hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. It is made clear that the respondent no. 3 shall be personally responsible for non-compliance of this order within the stipulated period.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of.
