ORAL ORDER

2 26-06-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Manjaul P.S. Case No. 19 of 2024 dated 30.04.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a), 30(b), 30(c) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 120 litres of illicit foreign liquor and other liquor making apparatus were recovered from the Bush.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been



implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioner no. 1 has one criminal antecedent and petitioner no. 2 has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioners are in custody since 01.05.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioners and the period of custody, the petitioners above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Begusarai, in connection with Manjaul P.S. Case No. 19 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
