ORAL ORDER

2 27-06-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in Jaynagar P.S. case No.
105 of 2024 instituted for the offences under Sections 272, 273,
414 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that 150 liters
liquor was recovered from the motorcycle and the petitioner is
arrested on spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner



has got no concern with either the alleged recovery of liquor or the motorcycle. The petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2024 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr.P.C.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Jaynagar P.S. case No. 105 of 2024.
