A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Bhimpur P.S Case No. 53 of 2024 dated 21.04.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 279, 337, 338 of the I.P.C. and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 288 litres of illicit Nepali country made liquor was recovered from the two different vehicles.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is the driver of the Bolero but he has no



concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Similarly situated co-accused has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 26.06.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 43999/2024. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 22.04.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Supaul in connection with Bhimpur P.S Case No. 53 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
