2 18-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for
issuance of an appropriate writ(s),
order(s), direction(s) for directing
the respondent authorities to
consider the case of petitioner for
selection on the post of Anganbari
Sevika as per advertisement in
Anganbari Centre No. 379 situated*



at Ward no.7 in Kapasia Panchayat on the basis of merit list in which petitioner is at Sl. no. 3 belongs to O.B.C. and others who are at Sl. No. 1 and 2 are in general categories and to grant any other consequential benefits for which petitioner may found entitled in accordance with law.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
