“1. i) For instance of an appropriate writ directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner on the post of Chaukidar after the death of his father in harness on compassionate ground in Mufassil P.S. Aurangabad

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Aurangabad for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the District Magistrate, Aurangabad, by filing appropriate representation, within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be disposed off by a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.
