2 18-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this application is being filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing /commending the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner her husband for grant of promotion i.e. ACPs w.e.f. due date in the light of Govt. resolution dated 25.03.2003 issued by the Finance Department, Govt. of Bihar and also grant the consequential benefit to the petitioner her husband with penal



interest @ 12% in the light of judgment passed by this Hon'ble Court, who died on 08.12.2015 during service."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondents authorities for redressal of her aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
