learned APP for the State.

2. In this case, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection with Neemchak Bathani P.S. Case No. 30 of 2024, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 392/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per allegation, when the informant was travelling in a passenger train, some unknown persons assaulted him and snatched away Rs. 5500 and some documents of the informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. Nothing was recovered from his possession. He is a person of clean antecedent. His name has figured in confessional statement of Kuleshwari Devi who is the purchaser of mobile set and in her statement she had stated that she



had purchased the mobile set from the petitioner.

5. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances as well as the clean antecedents, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gaya in connection with Neemchak Bathani P.S. Case No. 30 of 2024, subject to the following condition:-

The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
