ORAL ORDER

2 24-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Jalalpur P.S. Case No. 15 of 2024 dated 14.01.2024 registered for the offences punishable under sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 504 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused person surrounded the informant and the co-accused Sonu Kumar inflicted blow of knife on the head of the informant. The petitioner holding rod started assaulting with rod indiscriminately and he also assaulted on the chest of the informant with leg.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that four injuries are simple in nature and one injury is stated to be grievous. The petitioner has antecedent of two criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 28.03.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran at Chapra in connection with Jalalpur P.S. Case No. 15 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
