2 18-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari or any other appropriate writ/writs setting aside the speaking order dated 31.3.2020 contained in memo no.RBO/SSM/01 issued by Regional Manager-cum-Disciplinary Authority by which punishment of dismissal without notice has been



inflicted on the petitioner in terms of paragraph no.6(a) of the memorandum of settlement of disciplinary action for workman dated 10.4.2002 and or to grant any other relief or reliefs for which petitioner is legally entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
