2. This is second anticipatory bail petition. Earlier the petition, filed for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of petitioner, stood dismissed on merit, vide order dated 28.08.2023 passed in Cr.Misc. No. 54980 of 2023.

In view of the fact that no fresh ground has been pressed by petitioner for reconsideration of his prayer for pre-arrest bail as well as in view of the recent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***G.R.
