an alternative and efficacious remedy of approaching the
Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum (CGRF) under Section
42 (5) of the Electricity Act, 2003, this Court is not inclined to



entertain the present writ petition. The present writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the CGRF within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order. In case, any application/representation being made, the CGRF shall endeavour to pass necessary orders within a period of four weeks thereof strictly in accordance with law.

2. It is needless to mention that before passing any order the petitioner shall be given an opportunity of hearing. Any order passed shall be communicated to the party.

3. With the above directions, the present Writ Petition stands disposed of to the extent indicated.
