2 07-08-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Digha P.S. Case
No.474 of 2020, registered for the offence punishable u/s 20, 22
of the NDPS Act.

3. Altogether 31 sachets containing 65 grams of ganja was
recovered from co-accused Bittu Kumar and he disclosed that
petitioner and others deals in ganja.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence.
He has been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior
motive. Petitioner has been made accused in this case on the
basis of statement of co-accused. No incriminating contraband
article has been recovered from the conscious physical



possession of the petitioner. Charge has not been framed. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent in similar nature of offence and he is in custody since 23.04.2024.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail by submitting that petitioner has one criminal antecedent in similar nature of offence.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The prayer for grant of bail on his behalf is hereby rejected.

7. This application is accordingly dismissed.

8. However, petitioner is at liberty to renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge.
