3 23-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Jokihat P.S. Case No. 29 of 2024 registered under Sections 147,
149, 341, 323, 354-B, 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal
Code.

3. As per F.I.R., this petitioner along with other named
accused persons assaulted informant and her family members,
as a result of which they sustained injuries.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case due to ulterior motive. Further
submission is that the First Information Report has been lodged
after an inordinate delay of 4 days without assigning any



plausible explanation for delay. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus. The doctor has found the injury simple in nature. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail by contending that petitioner is named in the First Information Report with the allegation of assault.

6. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case as well as nature of injuries, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of eight weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Jokihat P.S. Case No. 29 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
