3 09-05-2024 The petitioner, husband of opposite party no. 2,

apprehends his arrest in a complaint case punishable for the

offence under Section 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for both the parties

submit that the dispute between the parties has been resolved

amicably through the process of mediation and both parties have

agreed to live separately and for this purpose, the petitioner

offered to pay **Rs. 6,51,000/-** (Rupees six lacs fifty one

thousand), as full and final settlement amount to opposite party

no. 2, which she has accepted.

3. Here, it is relevant to mention that earlier, vide

order dated 10.08.2023, with consent of the parties, the matter



was referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of Patna High Court to explore the possibility of settlement between the parties, which has been resolved, vide report of the Mediator, kept at flag ‘A’.

4. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of **Rs.10,000/-** (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Buxar in connection with Complaint Case No. 991(C) of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with further condition to *the petitioner shall abide by all the terms & conditions, mentioned in Memorandum of Agreement dated 01.05.2024 before the Mediation Centre, failing which, learned Court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail-bond of the petitioner.*
