- 2 05-07-2024 1. The present petition has been filed for restoration of

a writ petition bearing CWJC No.18048 of 2021, which has

stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution, by an order

dated 21.02.2024.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

the petitioner had approached the present counsel after taking no

objection from his earlier counsel but in the meantime the



aforesaid writ petition had stood dismissed for default by the aforesaid order dated 21.02.2024 inasmuch as by that time the present counsel could not file his *vakalatnama*, resulting in his name not being depicted in the daily cause list, leading to the present counsel being not able to appear before this Court when the case was taken up for hearing, thus, a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid writ petition be restored to its original file.
