2 10-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Rajpur
P.S. Case No. 147 of 2024 registered for the offence under
Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment)
Act, 2018.

3. The recovery is of 87 liters of illicit liquor.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and he is in custody since 10.05.2024.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is ready to donate Rs. 15,000/- in some charitable
organization without accepting his guilt.

6. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the
prayer for bail of the petitioner.



7. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Excise Court No. 01, Buxar in connection with Rajpur P.S. Case No. 147 of 2024.

8. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs. 15,000/- in Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Patna and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioner.
