3 24-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or directions to the Respondents to regularize the service of the Petitioner in Group-"D" in Jamui District after including his name in the Panel prepared for the appointment of candidates in Group-"D" in view of the Meeting held on 27.07.2019 in the Chairmanship of District Magistrate, Jamui and further for setting aside the decision taken in Clause-6(7) of the
