ORAL ORDER

2 03-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Saran Sadar Excise P.S. Case No. 116 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a)/32(3) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act. The petitioner is in custody since 15.04.2024.

3. There is recovery of 350 litres of illicit liquor. The petitioner was caught fleeing away from the car. The petitioner is in jail since 15.04.2024.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to donate Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) in some charitable organization without accepting his guilt.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 3rd Exclusive Special judge, Saran at Chapra concerned court in connection with Sadar Excise P.S. Case No. 116 of 2024.

6. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) in Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama at Chapra and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioner.

7. The petitioner is directed to mark his attendance in Ekma Police Station on 1st Sunday and 3rd Sunday of every month. Failure to do so, will result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.
