2 18-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this application is being
filed for issuance of writ/writs,
order/orders, direction/directions for
quashing the order dated
05.06.2021 passed by the
Respondent No. 3 in Anganbari
Sevika Appeal Case No. 70/2018-19*



issued through Memo No. 695 dated 05.06.2021 without waiting the report from Respondent No. 6 in response to letter no. 1761 dated 18.11.2019 written by Respondent No. 3 himself and for canceling the selection of the Respondent No. 9 as Anganbari Sevika of Anganbari Centre Ward No. 13 of Grampanchayat Dehti Uttar under Block-Palasi, District Araria because the selection of Respondent No. 9 has been made by the respondents on the basis of forged documents filed by the Respondent No. 9 and further direct the respondents to appoint the petitioner on the post of Anganbari Sevika of Anganbari Ward Centre No. 13 of Grampanchayat Dehti Uttar under Block-Palasi, District Araria because the petitioner is having higher marks among all the candidates and further direct the respondent No. 6 to produce before this Hon'ble Court all the original record of marks sheet obtained by the Respondent No. 9 because the different marks alleged to have



been obtained by her and accordingly the legal action may be taken against the erring respondents and further for any other relief or reliefs as the petitioner is found legally entitled to in the facts and circumstances of the case for the ends of justice.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a suit before the Ld. Civil Court having competent jurisdiction, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
