2 18-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

"1. That, the present writ petition is for direction to appropriate authority for grant of benefit in pre and post service as Commercial Tax Joint Commissioner instead to Commercial Taxes Deputy Commissioner taking into consideration his continuation against respective post in terms of the notification bearing Notification No. Go-34-4/2001-3782 dated 17.08.2001 till the date of superannuation as well as further prayer regarding payment of



interest upon the difference of pay and other benefits with litigating cost for unnecessary harassment and for the other necessary relief reliefs on basis of the facts and circumstances of the case as an enumerated, stated and discussed hereinafter."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondents authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
