2 15-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is in custody in connection
with Sangrampur P.S Case No. 309 of 2023 registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 32, 41
(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per allegation in the F.I.R., it is a case of
recovery total 23 litres country made liquor from the
bag of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. It
is further submitted that no incriminating article has



been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. On perusal of seizure list there is no independent witness and petitioner has not been arrested on spot. He further submits that the name of the petitioner surfaced on the statement of local Chaukidar. It is also submitted that petitioner is in judicial custody since 08.04.2024. Similarly situated co-accused person has already been granted bail by this court in Cr. Misc. No. 22838 of 2024 vide order dated 21.03.2024.

5. However, learned APP for the State oppose the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. On perusal of the FIR, impugned order and period of custody and also considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the above named petitioner be released on bail *after framing of the charge* on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 1, East Champaran at Motihari in connection



with Sangrampur P.S Case No. 309 of 2023.

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that *if the charge-sheet has not been submitted* then the petitioner shall be released on bail on the above conditions and he shall be present physically on each and every date before the trial court till conclusion of the proceeding of framing of charge.
