Aaganwari Appeal No. 14/2019 (Rambha Devi versus The State of Bihar and others) (Annexure 7) passed by Respondent Appellate Authority Respondent no. 3, District Magistrate, Gopalganj, by affirming the order dated 31.1.2019 passed by Respondent No. 4, the District Program Officer, Gopalganj, passed in Anganwari Appeal no 94/2018 (Smt. Nirmala Kumari vs. Child Development Project Officer, Birauli and others) (Annexure-6) and further prays for quashing of the order dated 31.1.2019 passed by Respondent no. 4, the District Program Officer, Gopalganj, passed in Anganwari Appeal no. 94/2018 (Smt. Nirmala Kumari vs. Child Development Project Officer, Birauli and others) (Annexure 6) whereby and whereunder the selection of Petitioner as Anganwari Sewika of Anganwari Centre no. 276, Ward no. 11, was set aside and in her place Respondent No. 7, appointed as Anganwari Sewika of Anganwari Centre No. 276 Ward No. 11, and Petitioner further prays for after setting aside both order, ensure and declare the Petitioner selection for the post was/ is valid as per the



Margdarshika of 2016 and entitled for payment of Mandey since her termination from the post and petitioner further prays for grant of any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner found entitled in the facts and circumstances of this case, is/are also given."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a suit before the Ld. Civil Court having competent jurisdiction, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
