learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in Muffassil (Lakho) P.S. Case No. 657 of 2023 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 341, 323, 325, 307, 379, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioners along with other co-accused persons are said to have assaulted the informant's side.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not



specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that there is admitted land dispute between the parties for way. He further submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioners. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the injured persons have sustained grievous injury.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of case and the nature of the injury, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is hereby rejected.
