ORAL ORDER

16 18-07-2024 I.A. No.04 of 2023 has been filed under Order 23

Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure. It is stated in the application that both parties have compromised their dispute out of their free will and mind and without any coercion and undue pressure from any corner. In support of the compromise petition, the appellant and the respondent have sworn their affidavits attached to the application.

2. Learned counsel for the parties submit that this appeal may be disposed off in terms of compromise and the compromise petition may be treated as form part of decree. The compromise petition is on record.
