ORAL ORDER

2 09-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Dighwara P.S. Case No. 143 of 2024 dated 10.05.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a), 41 (i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 180 litres of illicit country made liquor and liquor making apparatus were recovered from the bush in front of the ward no. 12 *Sitalpur Bazar Village*.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. As per impugned order dated 06.06.2024 the petitioner is in custody since 11.05.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner and the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran in connection with Dighwara P.S. Case No. 143 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
