A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 463 of 2024 dated 03.06.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 350 litres of illicit country made liquor kept in a gunny bags was recovered from the two motorcycles. It is further alleged that the said motorcycle was hidden in the bush.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is the owner of the said vehicle but he



has no concern with the alleged recovery. The said recovery has been made from an open place which is accessible to anyone. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran at Chapra in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 463 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
