of the petitioners for issuance of a writ
in the nature of Certiorari or any other
appropriate writ/ order or direction for
quashing the letter no. 5983 dated
23.06.2020 issued by the Additional
Secretary to the Government,*



Department of General Administration whereby and whereunder during the process of selection of the petitioners for appointment against the Class-IV post, the selection procedure has been changed in the midway which cause delay in issuance of appointment letters to the petitioners and further a direction be issued to expedite the matter of appointment of the petitioners and/or for issuance of such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances stated hereunder."
