ORAL ORDER

4 31-01-2024 The present M.J.C – Contempt petition is filed for non compliance of the order dated 07.01.2022 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 12882 of 2021. Direction is limited to the extent that petitioner was required to submit representation within a period of four weeks and, thereafter, within a period of four months grievance of the petitioner was required to be considered. Such grievance has been redressed on 31.03.2022 in passing certain order. If the



petitioner is not satisfied with the such order he has remedy before appropriate forum, for the reasons that petitioner is disputing certain payments issue. In other words, disputed facts are involved in the matter, therefore, petitioner has remedy of filing suit under the Commercial Courts Act or under C.P.C before the territorial jurisdiction forum.

2. Accordingly, the present M.J.C – Contempt petition stands dropped.
