ORAL ORDER

2 05-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in Warisliganj P.S. Case No. 05 of 2024, instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 120(B), 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 66(B)/66(D) of the IT Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, all the FIR named accused persons including this petitioner and 15-20 unknown persons are alleged to have been involved in the cyber fraud.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case merely on the basis of suspicion. No incriminating



material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner has got no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner is in custody since 05.01.2024 and has got no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 18.03.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 19381 of 2024.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner and claim based on parity, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Warisliganj P.S. Case No. 05 of 2024.
