2 23-10-2024 This revision petition has been preferred by the

petitioner for release of his vehicle i.e. Bolero Pickup having

registration no. JH-17X-4339 which has been seized in

connection with Ishipur Barahat P.S. Case NO. 101/2023 under

Section 7 of E.C. Act.

2. During course of argument, it is submitted by the

learned counsel for the petitioner that for releasing the said

vehicle the petitioner had made an application before the

has been registered.

3. According to the counsel, the said application is still pending before and no decision has been taken yet.
