ORAL ORDER

2 05-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in Piprakothi P.S. Case No. 59 of 2024, instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 467, 468, 471, 401, 413 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, on secret information police party apprehended the accused persons including the petitioner with a stolen motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for



the petitioner also submits that the petitioner has no concern with the recovered motorcycle. The petitioner is in custody since 20.03.2024 and has got one criminal antecedent in which the petitioner is on bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 25.06.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 42160 of 2024.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner and claim based on parity, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Piprakothi P.S. Case No. 59 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two



consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the
bail bonds of the petitioner.
