ORAL ORDER

5 18-07-2024 The instant petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction for transfer if Matrimonial (Divorce) Case No. 124 of 2018 filed by respondent no. 2 under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act and in the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Darbhanga to the appropriate Civil Court, Samastipur.
