2 01-08-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief(s):-

*“1.i. For transfer of the license of the Gun shop
M/s Suresh and Company Arms, Ammunition
Dealer and Repairing at Motijheel Muzaffarpur
to the name of petitioner.*

*ii. For issuance of direction to the respondents to
transfer of the license of the Gun shop M/s Suresh
and Company Arms, Ammunition Dealer and
Repairing at Motijheel Muzaffarpur to the name
of petitioner.*

*iii. For directing the respondent authority to pay
the compensation for not issuing the license of the
shop as which was the single source of income of
the petitioner.”*
