2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 30(a) and 32(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. Prosecution case relates to recovery of total 57 liters of country made liquor from a motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted from para-9 of this petition that the concerned vehicle does not belong to the petitioner. A statement has been made in para-3 of this petition that the petitioner has got no criminal



antecedent. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 08.06.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Excise Sherghati P.S. Case No. 92 of 2024 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise No.03, Gaya.
