2 30-07-2024 Heard Mrs. Bela Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned GP-26 for the State.

2. The petitioner in paragraph no. 1 of the present writ petition has sought, *inter alia*, following relief(s), which is reproduced hereinafter:

"(i) For directing and commanding the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioner in permanent establishment as he is working as sweeper since 2002 in the office of the respondent no.-7, Sub Divisional Officer, Tirhut Nahar Sub-Division, Motipur, District-Muzaffarpur.

(ii) Also for directing and commanding the respondent to give monetary benefit on the basis of regularization of his service.

(iii) Also for directing and commanding the respondent to pay his arrear of salary as per rule of permanent employee.

(iv) And also for any other relief/relieves for



which petitioner is found to be legally entitled under the facts and circumstances of the case."

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner, who is working on the post of sweeper since the year 2002, is being engaged by the respondent no. 7 (Sub Divisional Officer, Tirhut Nahar Sub-Division, Motipur, Muzaffarpur) who has kept his case pending for considering to regularize him. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner seeks to file a fresh detailed representation before the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Muzaffarpur.

4. The District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Muzaffarpur, is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner by calling the records relating to the petitioner, who has claimed to have worked in the office of respondent no. 7 regularly since the year 2002, and take a final decision well within a period of two months, in respect of regularization of the petitioner, in accordance with law.

5. With above observation/direction, the present writ petition is disposed of.
