seeking the following reliefs:-

"1. i) For issuance of a Writ in the nature of 'Mandamus' commanding the Respondent Authority to implement entire provision of Right to Information Act and Rules.

ii) For issuance of a writ in the nature of 'Mandamus' commanding the respondent to take action against the person who did not act upon the Right to Information Act and Rules.

iii) For issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, quashing the order dated 22.04.16, passed in Case No.82070/12-13, which was communicated by



Memo No.908 dated 03.05.16 to the petitioner whereby and whereunder the aforesaid case was disposed off without providing information.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
