A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Excise P.S. Case No. 222 of 2020 registered under Section 30(a)
of Bihar Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 20 liters illicit liquor has been
recovered from the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case due to police mechanism. Further
submission is that petitioner is neither the driver nor the owner
of the seized motorcycle from which the illicit liquor has been
recovered. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.



5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Exclusive Special Excise Court No. II, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 222 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
