ORAL ORDER

2 24-07-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well
as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Excise (Motihari) P.S. Case No. 979 of 2024 for the
offences punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act 2016.

3. As per allegation, on the tip off, the informant
along with police personnel reached the place of occurrence and
apprehended the petitioner from whose possession 51.9 liters of
illicit Nepali liquor was recovered from his bush.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. He has further submitted that nothing was recovered
from possession of the petitioner. He has also submitted that the



petitioner is a person of clean antecedent and is under custody since 16.06.2024.

5. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, as well as the clean antecedent of the petitioner, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court-2, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Excise (Motihari) P.S. Case No. 979 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
