ORAL ORDER

3 22-08-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Jehanabad P.S. Case No. 273 of 2024 dated 09.04.2024 registered for the offence/s punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, section 414 of the IPC and sections 21(1AA), 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 9 litres of illicit foreign liquor was recovered from the rented room of the co-accused Vicky Kumar and two live cartridges were recovered from the possession of the co-accused, namely, Shailesh Kumar.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The name of the petitioner was disclosed by the co-accused *Vikky Kumar*. Similarly situated co-accused has already been granted bail by the co-ordinate bench of this court *vide* order dated 03.07.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 46375 of 2024. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 09.04.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Jehanabad in connection with Jehanabad P.S. Case No. 273 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
