3 12-09-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1.a. For issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ/order or direction, directing the respondent no.3, to stop/restrain the erection of mobile tower in Laukha, Dist- Madhubani, in a residential area and/or direct the respondent no-3, to shift the said project (erection of mobile tower) outside the residential area.”
