ORAL ORDER

3 23-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in a case instituted
for the offence under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code,
registered in connection with Balua Bazar P.S. Case No. 8 of 2024.

3. As per prosecution case, some unknown persons have
looted the informant's motorcycle, mobile, cash and other articles.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. He
submitted that except confession, there is nothing against the
petitioner. The recovered mobile was not put on T.I.P. Petitioner is
in custody since 08.02.2024.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the



application for bail and submitted that during course of investigation, the name of the petitioner has figured in this case. He submitted that alleged stolen Sim Card No. 90417395XX has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and the same belongs to the informant, which has come in para-15 of the case diary and from para-14 of the case diary, it is also apparent that on the basis of self confession of the petitioner, the stolen articles have been recovered. He further submitted that **petitioner has been made accused in six more cases**. During investigation several witnesses have also supported the prosecution case.

6. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and considering the nature of allegation and **petitioner having strong criminal antecedents**, this court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail and, as such, his prayer for bail stands **rejected**.
