- 2 09-02-2024 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 17403 of 2022, which has stood dismissed for non-prosecution vide order dated 26.6.2023.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the counsel for the petitioners was engaged in another Court, he could not appear when the case was called out for hearing, hence, the aforesaid writ petition was dismissed for
