ORAL ORDER

2 22-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 226/2024 dated 11.05.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act and Sections 272 and 273 of the IPC.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 27.9 litres of illicit Nepali liquor was recovered from the jute bag near the graveyard which is alleged to be kept by the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious



possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 19.05.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 226/2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
