The pending Title Suit No. 166 of 2020 and 172 of 2020 shall be decided by the Court below within a year from the date of receipt/communication of a copy of this order without giving any unnecessary adjournment to any side. The Court below is also given liberty to proceed ex-parte against the non-cooperating party.

4. The petitioner is given liberty to file an amendment petition/fresh suit claiming the damages in accordance with law.

5. The petitioner is also given liberty to file a fresh injunction application which shall be considered by the Court below within a week of its filing on its merits. This Court has not considered this case on merits.

6. With the aforesaid directions, this application is disposed of.
