2 06-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the notice issued under letter no.4215 dated. 18/06/2024 by the Circle Officer, Patna Sadar in Encroachment Case No.10/2023-2024 whereby and whereunder petitioners have been directed to remove the Encroachment from Mauza-Sandalpur, Thana No.11; Khata No.850,849,889; Khesra No.2207,22084,2209.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty behalf of the petitioners to prosecute the
