3 06-09-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504/34 of the
Indian Penal Code, later Section 302 of the IPC was also added
in connection with Town (Nawada) P. S. Case No.474 of 2024.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submit that
the petitioners are persons with clean antecedent and the
informant alleges that Arif was assaulting his son by a rod
pulled from a Tota, on which the informant asked why he is
assaulting his son when accused persons including the
petitioners started assaulting by *lathi*, rod, bricks etc. On
account of which named persons got injured.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that



petitioners have been falsely implicated in the instant case. It is also submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners. It is next submitted that petitioners are not a criminal.

5. The learned APP for the State opposes the bail application.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petitioners above-named is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in connection with Town (Nawada) P. S. Case No.474 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
